



Assistance League of Orange, a chapter of National Assistance League, is an all-volunteer, nonprofit organization. Active volunteers of all ages serve their community through fundraising to support the following eleven philanthropic programs.

PHILANTHROPIC PROJECTS

DENTAL HEALTH CENTER offers dental care and education for children attending school in the Orange Unified School District (OUSD). We see children whose families are not receiving any federal or state aid and qualify for no other dental care assistance.

OPERATION SCHOOL BELL® supplies new school uniforms and shoe vouchers to students referred by Orange Unified School District Health Services. Students receive uniforms, socks, underwear, sweatshirts, hygiene kits, shoe vouchers and school supplies.

KIDS ON THE BLOCK® is a program developed for students in grades 3 and 4. Featuring life-size puppets, students learn how to deal with real-life issues including gangs, disabilities, divorce and drug abuse.

ORANGWOOD CHILDREN'S HOME for abused, abandoned and neglected children allows our volunteers to visit and provide both emotional support and activities for resident children of all ages.

HALOS (Helping A Little One Succeed) is a reading tutor/mentor program yielding significant impact. Our members work "one on one" with students to improve their reading skills.

HUMOR, HAPPINESS AND HEALTH provides companionship, entertainment and crafts to senior residents of Orange.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS provide financial support to deserving high school seniors who live in Orange or attend school in the Orange Unified School District. The Eugenia "Genie" Love Fine Art Scholarship provides financial aid to a college Art Major.

SPECIAL ASSISTANCE provides financial support for pressing household obligations to residents in desperate need within the city of Orange.

LINKS TO LEARNING offers an opportunity to enhance and/or develop new or different approaches to middle school teaching by granting monetary awards to teachers, school counselors and media specialists.

OPERATION HUG provides specially identified teddy bears for children in trauma.

HANDLE WITH CARE provides care packages to parents with critically ill children at UCI.
